

CCC Horseman of the Year Nominee Sandee Proctor

Sandee Proctor began her equestrian career as a youth showing Western (equitation, pleasure, trail and stock horse competitions) and English (Hunt Seat equitation, pleasure, bridle path hack, and jumping). In 1963, she opened her own stable where she bred and showed Quarter Horses. Sandee showed on the Quarter Horse circuit successfully and also became an accredited judge with what was then known as the American Horse Shows Assoc.

In the mid 1970's Sandee was asked to show the Paint stallion, 21 Jewels, and from that time on, she has focused her attention entirely to Paint Horses and their promotion. Sandee has shown many horses to club and state titles.

Believing that communication is the key to success, in 1999 Sandee saw a need for Paint exhibitors to access CCC information in a more timely manner and she created and developed Horseservices.com, a web site that offers free sites to CCC and California Regional Clubs. In the past, exhibitors waited for state points and messages to be published in a monthly paper periodical and the points were always thirty to forty-five days behind. Online sites have enabled Paint Horse owners and exhibitors to be more informed and connected to CCC, clubs and show management. Sandee continues to spend hours revising Paint Horse sites to keep everyone up to date.

During her career, Sandee has dedicated countless volunteer hours by creating club newsletters, show premiums and club forms. Sandee served as the Northern California Championship Circuit chairperson for several years. She is currently President of Sierra Paint Horse Club and has served as President and Secretary several times in the past. Sandee served on the CCC board for many years and was CCC Secretary for six years. She currently serves as a member of the Equine Medication Monitoring Committee for the State of California representing the California Paint Horse industry.
